Grant Considerations

- Grants will generally be awarded for 12-month periods; grant recipients are encouraged to seek diversified funding.
- MCHF will consider paying up to 15% of indirect costs on a caseby-case basis. In some instances there may be restrictions.
- Renewal grants are not assured and all required reports must be submitted for a renewal to be considered.
- Collaboration is encouraged, but applicants may not regrant funds without pre-approval.
- Audited financial statements for the most recently completed fiscal year are required of all organizations. Applicant organizations that cannot meet this requirement may be eligible for an exemption on a case-by-case basis upon review of the full grant application.
- A project budget must be submitted; site visits may be required.

Letter of Inquiry (LOI) Form

- **<u>Project Name</u>**: Clear, concise phrases with titles that have direct relevance to the proposed project.
- **<u>Requested Grant Amount:</u>** \$75,000 \$1,000,000 is the preferred range.
- <u>**Project Status:**</u> MCHF will consider funding new initiatives, expansions or enhancements of existing initiatives, renewal of previous MCHF grants, or existing projects that otherwise could not continue without additional financial support.
- <u>**Target Population:**</u> Projects must serve one of MCHF's priority populations and be specifically focused on low-income New York residents OR underserved/disadvantaged New Yorkers from various socioeconomic backgrounds.
- **<u>Project Description</u>**: Provide clear overview of what you hope to accomplish and how it will benefit low-income New Yorkers.
- <u>Planned Use of Grant Funds:</u> Must use MCHF budget template.
- <u>Goals and Intended Outcomes:</u> Please provide quantitative, resultsbased metrics including the number of people to be served and/or total number of services to be rendered.

What is Required in the Application?

- Narrative Components
 - Organizational Overview, Ongoing Programs
 - Description of Project, including Mission Alignment
 - Populations Served, Outcomes, Metrics, Partnerships, Key Roles and Responsibilities
- Budgets
 - Organizational Budget
 - Detailed Project Budget (MCHF Template)
- Supporting Documentation
 - Proof of Tax Exempt Status
 - Most Recent 990 and Audited Financials (if applicable)
 - Annual Report
 - Largest Funders
 - List of Board of Directors
 - CEO Signature
